

Declaration of Conformity



Why you need it, when it's
valid and how to obtain it.

The Declaration of Conformity

- 📄 ...is an official certificate drawn up by the manufacturer or their authorised representative.
- 🛡️ ...declares that a product complies with all relevant European product safety requirements.
- 📄 ...is a mandatory legal document which must accompany all CE marked products sold or traded in the EU.



When is it valid?

- ⚙️ A DoC is valid when it meets and mentions all relevant legal standards and testing procedures.
- 👤 This can be verified by the responsible party indicated on the certificate, or a third party with compliance expertise.
- ✅ It is valid for an indefinite period of time so long as there are no major product changes (e.g. change of original operation, intended use or type).
- 📅 The DoC must be kept at least ten years after the last date of manufacture of the product.

How to obtain the DoC?

Before signing the Declaration of Conformity, you must first ensure that your product complies with all relevant EU standards for health and safety by completing the CE marking process:

Analyze product characteristics and identify applicable legislation

Screen the level of compliance and carry out testing if necessary

Compile the technical file

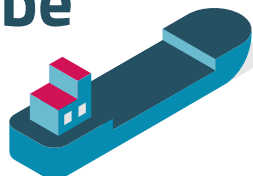

Draft the Declaration of Conformity and affix the CE mark logo
